William Butler Yeats (1865-1939)

A young Irish pilot, flying for the British Royal Air Corps, reviews his divided loyalties as he contemplates death. Yeats wrote this shortly after World War I when Ireland was still part of the British Empire.

I know that I shall meet my fate Somewhere among the clouds above; Those that I fight I do not hate, Those that I guard I do not love; My county is Kiltartan Cross, My countrymen Kiltartan's poor,

No likely end could bring them loss Or leave them happier than before. Nor law, nor duty bade me fight, Nor public men, nor cheering crowds, A lonely impulse of delight Drove to this tumult in the clouds; I balanced all, brought all to mind, The years to come seemed waste of breath, A waste of breath the years behind In balance with this life, this death.
